\*\* The increase in the State budget expenditures in the function "Social protection and social security" in January 2020 on the year-over-year basis is caused by a change in the mechanism of granting privileges and housing subsidies in 2020. Thus, in 2020, expenditures that in 2019 were financed from the subvention from the State budget, were transferred to the Ministry of Social Policy, in particular, the subvention for social benefits to families with children, low-income families and children with disabilities, and the subvention for allowances to orphans and children deprived of parental care were included in the budget program Code 2501030 "Payment of certain types of benefits, compensations, financial support and selected services to some categories of the population" and the subvention for the provision of privileges and housing subsidies to the households to pay for housing and utilities and the subvention for the provision of privileges and housing subsidies to the households for the purchase of solid fuel and liquefied gas were included into the budget program Code 2501230 "Payment of privileges and housing subsidies, purchase of solid fuel and liquefied gas in cash form." Accordingly, intergovernmental transfers in the reporting period were substantially reduced.
