






Redistribution of GDP through Budget Revenues (excluding inter-budgetary transfers)












The share of VAT in the GDP in 2018-2021










State Budget Expenditures and Lending in 2021 (by functional categories)
















Consolidated Budget Expenditures on Defense and Security, 2018-2021







Dynamic of the State debt and State-Guaranteed Debt, % to GDP








State Debt and Financing Sources of the General Fund of the Budget in 2021
